

# MAHARSHI SANDIPANI RASHTRIYA VEDA VIDYA PRATISTHAN, UJJAIN

Indicative Syllabus & Examination Pattern for the Post of Staff Car Driver.

- **The examination will consist of the following stages:**
  1. Written Examination (MCQs Based) – 100 Marks
  2. Skill Test (Qualifying)- the candidate will be assessed (On the basis of Assessment criteria given below) and minimum benchmark for qualifying the skill test will be 60 points out of 100 points.
  3. Medical Examination of recommended candidates
- 1. **Written Examination:** The Written Examination will consist of one objective-type multiple-choice paper containing 100 questions carrying 100 marks, with the following composition-

- The question paper will be of Class 10<sup>th</sup> Level.
- The Written Examination will be conducted in English & Hindi only.
- Tentative Answer Key will be uploaded on the MSRVP's website after the examination. Candidates may go through the Answer Key and submit representations, any representation regarding Answer Key received within the time limit fixed by the Pratishtan at the time of uploading of the Answer Key will be scrutinized before finalizing the Answer Key and the decision of the MSRVP in this regard will be final. No representation regarding Answer Key shall be entertained later.

- **Syllabus for Written Examination:**

**Part-A: General Awareness:** Question in this component will be aimed at testing the candidate's general awareness around him. Questions will also be designed to test his knowledge of current events and of such matters of every day observations and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Indian Economy, General Polity, Indian Constitution, Scientific Research, etc. These Questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

**Part B: General Intelligence:** Analytical aptitude and ability to observe and distinguish patterns will be tested through questions principally of nonverbal type. This component may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, spatial visualization, spatial orientation, visual memory, discrimination, observations, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasons and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non-verbal series, coding and decoding, etc.

**Part C: Numerical Ability:** This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental Arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, Mensuration, Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and Work, etc.

**Part D: Road Sense, Vehicle Maintenance, Traffic Rules/Signals, Vehicle & Environmental Pollution:** Questions related to Road Sense, Vehicle Maintenance, Traffic Rules / Signals /

Signages, vehicle & environmental pollution, i.e., petrol and diesel vehicle, CNG operated vehicle, Noise pollution, Offence/Penalties & Procedures etc.

## 2. Skill Test (Minimum bench mark – 60 Points):

The candidates who qualify the Written Tests will be called for Skill Test. The Driving License of all the candidates who qualify the Written Tests will be verified and only those candidates whose Driving Licenses are found genuine will be allowed to appear in the Skill Test. The candidate will also produce valid Driving License (in original) at the time of Skill Test. Necessary legal action will be taken against those candidates whose Driving License are found forged/false.

**The Skill/Trade Test shall carry 100 Points (Minimum bench mark – 60 Points)** The Skill Test will be qualifying in nature only to assess the Skills of the candidates. However, on the basis of the assessment in the Skill Test the candidate will be declared either qualified or not qualified. The minimum bench mark for qualifying the skill test will be 60 %. Any candidate who doesn't secure the minimum points in the skill test will not be allowed to appear in further recruitment process. So candidates must obtain at least the minimum qualifying points as shown in the table below to be allowed for appearing further process. The Skill Test shall cover the following aspects and the Board will award the points of each test as indicated below:-

S.No.	Assessment Criteria	Total Points (100)
1	All checks before engine starting and knowledge about vehicle sensor and signals and rear view mirror adjustment and safety measures such as seat belts etc.	10
2	Smooth straight head driving with gears changing, top gear speed, change to lower gear from top gear in different traffic condition.	10
3	Vehicle uphill and downhill operations stop and restart at steep gradient without rolling back.	10
4	The technique of overtaking, giving pass, change of lanes and lane driving and other precautions.	10
5	Use of hand signals and electric signals, emergency stops, precautions & safety.	10
6	Vehicle reversing, garaging on & off side and taking out vehicle from different restrictions, turning of vehicle left, right and stopping etc.	10
7	Show courtesy and consideration for the safe and convenience of other road users specially ambulance and other emergency services, pedestrians, drivers of other motor vehicles and cyclist.	10
8	Knowledge about mandatory, warning and informatory road signs.	10
9	Knowledge about driver's duty in case of distress/accident.	10
10	Knowledge about maintenance of vehicle/motor mechanism (candidate should be able to remove minor defects including tyre change/pressure, battery water level, Quantity & grade of oils to be used, Coolant, tension of belts/hose pipes etc. in vehicle).	10

## 3. Medical Standard:

- The candidates should be of sound health, free from disease/defect/ deformity.
- Better eye vision 6/6 without glasses. Free from colour blindness. No relaxation is allowed/ permissible.
- The selected candidates shall be medically examined by civil surgeon of Govt. Hospital/authorized medical practitioners.

**\* The final selection will be based solely on the marks obtained in the Written Examination, subject to qualifying the Skill Test and fulfilment of the medical standards as verified/certified by civil surgeon of Govt. Hospital/authorized medical practitioners.**
